Design Your Own Cover

The following designs might inspire you! Some were created by an individual, a yearbook committee or by our design team. The back cover of your yearbook can be designed as part of a coherent theme with the front or can be entirely independent. Let your imagination run free and come up with something completely original.

For a full cover design, remember to include the back cover and the spine in your design. Whether creating a cover in PhotoShop, Publisher or scanning it in, remember that the resolution (300dpi) of your image is vital to ensuring it prints clearly. And always include 'bleed' (an additional 3mm of image to all sides) keeping your text and important elements away from the edges.



Design sizes

Front cover only:

- A4 Softback: 216mm x 303mm
- A4 Hardback: 236cm x 323cm
- B5 Softback: 173cm x 246cm
- B5 Hardback: 193cm x 266cm

Full cover (front & back) design:
You may need to add a little more for the spine if your book is large.

- A4 Softback: 440cm x 303cm
- A4 Hardback: 460cm x 323 cm
- B5 Softback: 360cm x 246cm
- B5 Hardback: 380cm x 266cm
